A student: Earlier [Baba] refused it [to be the part] of Kashi.

Baba: It is being recorded in the *tape recorder*, why do you speak like this? Has anyone heard that Kashi wasn't said to be the dearest city?

A student: He did say [Kashi nagri] to be the dearest...

Baba: So, when she is dear, she is good, isn't she? She is in the heart. Is it good to reside in the heart, is it good to reside on the head or is it good to sit, to reside on the lap?

A student: [It is good to reside] in the heart.

Baba: Yes, it is the best to have a seat on the throne of heart.

A student: Such an occasion comes in the life of every man, then can every person say that Shiva is ungrateful?

Baba: What did the mother say?

Student: Such an occasion comes in the life of every man that the one who accompanies for the entire life, doesn't accompany at the last time.

Baba: Does every soul play the same part?

Student: No. Does it happen like this in everyone's life or not?

Baba: Yes, it does. There is no such soul in this world whom Maya never takes in her clutches.

Student: Then, does anyone say that Shiva is also ungrateful?

Baba: I said that some person remains a helper for the entire life, since the beginning till the end. He helps through the body, through the mind, through wealth, through time, through contacts, through relationships. He doesn't desire to take anything. Should we be grateful to him or not? He is not God, is he? It doesn't matter even if someone isn't grateful to God, because God is God anyway. But the humans are not like that. Like what? [They are not such] that they would remain helpers birth after birth. So, shouldn't [the Father] be grateful to the soul who remains His helper birth after birth?

Student: He should be [grateful].

Baba: Should he be grateful to the others? To the ones who betrayed him in between or didn't help at all because of fear? (Concluded.)
