Topic - God comes in which chariot?

God of the Gita says, 'I certainly come in an ordinary body'. In what kind of a body do I come? (Students: ordinary.) Why? I come in an ordinary body so that only My intelligent children who are the children of the Intellectual Father are able to recognize Me, not others. I come in a fortunate body. It is certainly an ordinary body but it is fortunate. In what sense, on what basis is it fortunate? When it is the chariot of God, how is it? A fortunate chariot. And it isn't the *temporary* chariot. What kind of a chariot? The permanent chariot. The Father is revealed through that chariot from the beginning till the end. This is why it is permanent.
