<u>Short No. 91, VCD - 1151</u> <u>Topic - How to recognise God present in one?</u>

He has to enter [him] to prove [him to be] the permanent chariot. Otherwise the Brahmakumarkumaris do narrate this to the world, that God is not omnipresent. They narrate this, don't they? And the people also listen to them. They nod their head and say: Yes, you are right, [God] is not omnipresent. But does any Brahmakumar say that if He is not omnipresent, then where is He present in one being? Does anyone explain [this]? (Students: No.) When they don't explain [this], then it is not proved that He is not omnipresent. Otherwise, they should say where He is present in one [chariot]. So, they don't have the knowledge of His being present in one [chariot] and they will not have this knowledge until God Himself comes and enters some permanent chariot and gives this knowledge.
