
HOW DOES BHARAT RISE AND FALL?

The picture of the Ladder is especially for the *Bharatvaasis* (residents of Bharat). 5000 years ago, there was the Ancient Deity Religion (*Aadi Sanaatan Devi-Devata Dharm*) in Bharat, but the human beings have completely forgotten it. At present, all the *Bharatvaasis* have forgotten their original religion and original task; so, they call themselves Hindu. There was one religion in the vice less world. There weren't vices there at all, there wasn't any vice at all. So, it is called the vice less world. All the deities there didn't consider themselves a body, rather, they considered themselves an incorporeal soul; so, they were incorporeal as well as vice less. Then, there is no ego in the deities at all. 5000 years ago, when this Bharat was heaven, everyone was stabilized in the stage of the self, they were very healthy, wealthy and pure. There was no need to take any treatment and so on. They were so wealthy that there was no need to do any business etc.; there was immense wealth.

But today, Bharat has become poor. Bharat alone is the country where maximum number of people of various religions are living, there is no other country like this. And when people of various religions have gathered [here], there will be disputes based on the religion, won't there? Bharat alone is the country where there are many castes. There isn't hatred based on these castes in any other country. Bharat alone is the country where there are many provinces, many states; there aren't disputes based on the states in any other country. The country of Bharat is such where there are many languages. There is one language in one village and another language in another village two kilometers [away from it] and they fight [among themselves] a lot based for those languages. In Bharat, they worship many [deities]. We fall because of adulterated bhakti. When the intellect delights in many, the soul definitely experiences a great fall. People of other religions know their religion, they know their task, they know their religious father and they know their religious land. Only the Bharatvaasis are such that they don't know their religious father at all. When they don't know him at all, how will they believe in him? There is no land highly pure like Bharat at all and when this very land of Bharat becomes taamasi (degraded), there is no religious land highly impure like it at all. Whoever becomes satopradhaan to whatever extent, he also becomes taamasi to that extent. So, Bharat that was highly pure, that Bharat and Bharatvaasis became highly impure.



When people become impure, they just keep remembering in Bharat itself: 'O Purifier of the impure! Come'. They don't remember [like this] in other countries, because the people of other religious lands and other countries don't become very impure [and] sorrowful at all, so, they call Him in Bharat alone. The one who liberates all of us from the bondage of sorrow is the one incorporeal, unique Soul. We call Him 'Shiva' and not just in Bharat, but in the other countries of the world too, those Shivling, the remembrance (yaadgaar) of Shiva are found. It is written in the Gita: "Yadaa yadaa hi dharmasya glaanih bhavati..." (Chapter 4, shloka 7) [It means,] whenever there is defamation of the religion and not just one religion, but there is defamation of all the religions, when the people of all the religions fight with each other, beat and kill [each other], it is defamation, isn't it? Then, God comes. Mahaashivaraatri is celebrated in Bharat alone, not in the foreign countries. Bharat is certainly an imperishable land, because it is the birthplace of imperishable God. Especially Uttar Pradesh in North India is considered the land of birth of God where the Supreme Soul, the Father is born in the form of revelation. When that incorporeal Shiva comes in this world, the one who He enters is the first man of the world who is called as 'Aadam' by the Muslims. The progeny of Aadam are men (aadami). What are we all? We are the progeny of Aadam. The Christians call him 'Adam', the Jains call him 'Adinath' and he is called 'Adidev (the first deity)' among the Hindus. Tvam aadidevah purushah puraanah (Gita chapter 11, shloka 38). [It means,] the most ancient man is Adidev or Adi Narayan (the first Narayan); there is no other Narayan before him at all. In his very remembrance, in the region of Bharat, the story of Satyanarayan (the true Narayan) is narrated in every house. When the story of Satyanarayan is narrated, it is proved that Satyanarayan will have struggled against falsity. It is said only in Bharat, 'Satyam Shivam Sundaram (true, beneficial, beautiful)'. When true God arrives, He is called 'Sat'. True God comes, teaches the knowledge of Raja yoga, transforms the Iron Age and establishes the Golden Age. This is why, the ancient Raja yoga of Bharat is very famous. Bharat becomes impure through the colour of the company of many and just by coming in the colour of the company of that one Adidev, Bharat becomes pure. The meaning of Bharat is: 'Bha' means light [and] 'rat' means to be engaged, [i.e.] the one who remains engaged in the light of knowledge. Now, it is the fall of Bharat and the Golden Age is called the rise.
